

Canton Academy Directed Studies Program

Preparing all Students to Succeed

The Directed Studies Program is designed to run parallel and in conjunction with the standard school classes offered at Canton Academy. Students enrolled in the program will have assistance and supplemental classroom instruction and reinforcement, while accommodations are made that are deemed necessary in relation to the student's specific learning needs.

Criteria for Enrollment:

1. Student must have current testing (no more than two (2) years old) including a psychological evaluation and achievement scores.
2. Copy of most recent report card
3. Standardized testing results
4. Work sample/writing sample (if applicable)

Elementary School K – 6th The Directed Studies Program will be offered for those students meeting above enrollment criteria and needing remediation in all areas of the curriculum. Students enrolled will meet three to five times per week for remediation and be taught individualized study techniques meeting identified needs.

Middle & High School 7th – 12th Students enrolled in the Directed Studies Program will be in all regular classes offered at Canton Academy. Students will attend one Directed Study class per day to supplement their curriculum to meet their learning needs. Specific learning needs will be identified and individual learning strategies will be implemented for each child enrolled. The Directed Study teacher will provide test taking skills, study skills and instructional reinforcement.
